# **Butte County Shooting Sports Begins**

Happy New Year!!! We are ready to start our 2023 season of 4-H Shooting Sports. Dues this year are \$45/youth less any discount you might have earned for selling wreaths in October. Please come prepared to pay this fee at the first practice you attend by cash or check. The fee covers consumables such as targets, arrows, pellets, BB's, maintenance, etc. There will be additional fees to send in your scores for Statewide qualification matches and State Shoot. New Members - We will again focus training efforts on our new members for the first two weeks of practice which begins this Thursday, 1/5. If your family has both new members and returning members, please use SignUp Genius to register your new members and bring the returning members along and we can fill them in on a space available basis. Also, for those families who have conflicts with wrestling practice or other things later in the season, you are welcome to come these first two weeks as well on a walk-in basis if space is available on the line.

**Practices** will be Thursdays from 6-8 PM and Sundays from 1-4 PM. Pick the date that works best for your family. There are at least 25 regular practice dates between January and the end of March and each participant must attend a minimum of 7 in order to complete the project year and be eligible for State Shoot and awards. We will use SignUp Genius to secure a spot on the line (please limit to once per week per event) and then fill in the lines with walk-ins as space is available. We started using this method during Covid and it has worked well for those who drive from a distance or need specific times to plan for other events while still allowing flexibility for those whose schedule opens up at the last minute. You should be able to find the various SignUp Genius link throughout the year here. You will be limited to signing up 14 days in advance and the old dates will drop off.



# More Jr. Leader Fun Planned





# **RYLF** offering financial assistance for CWF

Youth are encouraged to apply for 2023 4-H Citizenship Washington Focus trip A South Dakota delegation of 4-H youth will travel by bus to Washington DC on June 17-24, 2023 for the annual Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) trip. This leadership opportunity is one of the BEST that 4-H offers and local Butte-Lawrence 4-H members ages 15 and older (by June 2023) are encouraged to contact the Butte County office to apply for the trip. The trip cost is \$2200, however travel scholarships are available locally through the Redwater Youth Leadership Fund to cover all but \$500 to 600 of the cost. And, youth can use any banked "points" from recognition program toward this remaining cost. Butte Lawrence County can send 2 youth and possibly more, so if you have an interest, see the link below for more information and contact Cindy at the office to get a packet to apply for the travel scholarship. Deadline to contact the office is Dec. 20. 
# **Camp "Gift" Option**


